## Yellow Bag Program

Volume based trash collection applies the same principle that utilities such as water and electric systems use. Your cost is based on the amount of waste you discard.

The less you throw away...  
the less you pay!

**Base cost:** The basic monthly rate included on your water bill is \$12.58.

**Bag cost:** Specially marked yellow bags are available in two sizes. 30 gallon bags are \$0.75 and 15 gallon bags are \$0.35. These can be purchased at Hart's Grocery, City Hall, or Public Works.

*\*Trash fees now subject to Arkansas sales tax.*

**Time** Please have trash at the curb before 5:00 a.m.

## What Can I Recycle in My Green Bin?

### Aluminum

*Cans, foil, and pie plates*



### Steel Cans



### Plastic (Bottles Only)

*If it is not a bottle with a neck, it cannot be recycled*



### Newsprint & Mixed Paper

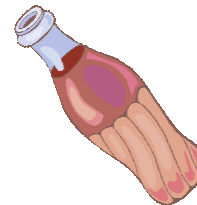


*All paper should be bagged and placed on top of bin.*



### Glass Containers

*(Jars and Bottles Only)*



## When Can I Recycle?

Recycling pick up will be the same day as trash service. For items not included in the curbside green bin program, check the list of other disposal options.

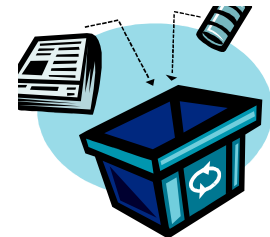
## How Do I Recycle?

Recycling is easy! Simply rinse your items and place loosely in your bin with bagged newsprint on top. **The only item accepted in a bag is newsprint.** Place bin at curbside on the same day as your trash service.

## Place All Items Inside the Bin ...

### NO BAGS!

Except for newsprint, items that are placed in bags will not be collected. If you need an extra bin, call for information at the Recycle Center.
